
## SAN DIEGO COUNTY DISTRICT 2 POLL


Anderson leads Jacobs district-wide 31% to 18%. He leads among GOP 52% to 7% and among Independents 23% o 20%. Trails among Democrats 14% to 30%.

Anderson leads among voters concerned about immigration, 58% to 6%, and those concerned about cost of living, 30% to 12%. He trails among housing affordability voters, 22% to 38%, and is tied among homelessness voters, 23% to 23%.
